


Conclusion

MAT works best in young patients with limited cartilage wear!




Acellular Meniscus Scaffolds Implantation for partial defects



Typical Indication

- Remaining pain after extensive partial meniscectomy (3-7cm)
- Meniscus rim and horns intact
- Cartilage in good shape (max ICRS grade 3)
- Stable and well-aligned knee





- Make sure the tendon popliteus rim is intact!

Use horizontal sutures

SQUARE




Since scaffold is the weaker link:
Amount of tissue included in
sutures is most important factor!

Tips and Tricks

- Use Horizontal sutures!
- Do not overtighten the sutures




Tips and Tricks

- Femoral condyle squaring is exclusion!





defect assessment, look for anterior and posterior horn and intact rim



enhance healing by microfracturing and shaving the rim




defect size, oversize scaffold by 10%







**cut scaffold to size and introduce in defect, use
large grasper**



**horizontal all-inside suture between native
horn and scaffold, tighten gently**



horizontal inside out sutures at anterior horn




Take home message
